

2009 Russian River Valley Pinot Noir

Kathleen describes this wine as her “affordable luxury Pinot”, and the delicious 2009 Russian River Pinot Noir is exactly that. This is a serious wine which provides Kathleen’s unmistakable winemaking signature at a more accessible price.

The labels for our Russian River Valley Pinot are made from tree-free stock and have been printed using eco-friendly inks. We have also discontinued the use of foil on this label to minimize the environmental impact. The fruit sources are our organically farmed Olivet Grange Vineyard and the Klopp’s sustainably farmed Thorn Ridge Ranch.

Tasting Notes

Color: Bright garnet

Aroma: cherry, raspberry, black tea, sassafras and baking spices

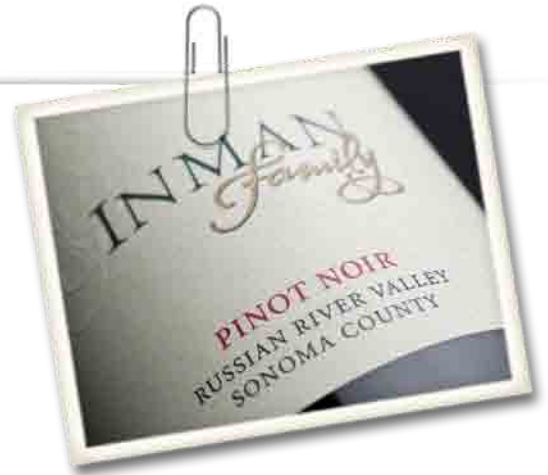
Flavor: Red fruit dominates the flavor profile. Mouthwatering perception of acid makes this a fabulous food wine. Layers of ripe cherry, dried cranberry, rhubarb and raspberry fruits combine with notes of cinnamon and earthy minerality. The wine is elegant, finessed and well balanced with long ‘cranberry zing’ finish which lingers. The texture is silky and the wine is medium bodied with fine tannins.

Vineyard Notes

The fruit is from both Olivet Grange Vineyard and Thorn Ridge Ranch.
