

Whole Buncha Love 2022

This is our proprietary red blend which in this vintage is a luscious and delicious blend of old vine Grenache from the Sceales Vineyard in Alexander Valley and Pinot Noir from the Pratt Vine Hill Vineyard. This was the first time working with the Sceales Vineyard, a beautiful section of Grenache planted in the mid-1950s. Excellent vineyard pedigree for both the Grenache and Pinot Noir has resulted in a wine that bursts with crunchy red fruit, has a rich mouth feel and a long finish.

Both lots were fermented separately using only wild yeast, basket pressed and settled overnight before their barrels were filled. They aged separately in a blend of new and older French oak barrels before being blended and bottled in July 2023.

Aroma: Strawberries, both fresh and cooked, orange peel, hints of cherry and beeswax

and the wine has a long finish.
